

# PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE CONSTITUTION, ADMINISTRATIVE RULES AND RULES OF PLAY – 2010 SEASON (Version 2)

There were no amendments received from Clubs

Proposed by the Management Committee:

## A: CONSTITUTION

### Motion 1

*To increase the administration fee charged for disciplinary appeals to cover incurred costs*

#### 12 DISCIPLINE – add the following

- 12.3 In line with the ECB disciplinary model rules (section 6.1) , a club or player has the right of appeal, which should be submitted in writing to the General Secretary within the time specified, together with an administrative fee of £50

## B: ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

### Motion 2

*In order to discourage clubs dropping top players into SEPCL 2<sup>nd</sup> XI at the seasons end, change 4.2 to read:- Take out that crossed through and add Large Italics*

#### 4 ELIGIBILITY OF PLAYERS

- 4.2 After 31st July no club may play in a minor XI in the League more than two players who have each played more than ~~eight~~ *six* games in a more senior Saturday XI of the club.

### Motion 3

*Add the requirement for Division 1 clubs to use Play Cricket for on line registrations*

#### 4.3 REGISTRATION OF PLAYERS

**Add 4.3.4** – Division 1 Clubs will be required to use Play Cricket for on-line player registrations as directed by the Management Committee

## Motion 4

*Add a clause regarding the registration of players with debt to a previous club, which is currently only referred to in relation to transfers.*

### 4 ELIGIBILITY OF PLAYERS

**Add the following to 4.1 : General Conditions** – No player shall be eligible to register for a member club while there is debt owed to a previous club. Evidence must be available to prove the existence of such debt

Either party shall have the option to ask the league to conduct a hearing and/or investigation in relation to the outstanding debt. Such request should be made no later than 60 days from the decision of the player to move clubs. The decision reached by the league shall be final and binding.

## Motion 5

*In line with a change of ECB regulations – reduce the number of qualifying months.  
Change shown in bold*

### 4 ELIGIBILITY OF PLAYERS

**4.3.1 Category 3 (Exempt)** - Overseas players ordinarily resident in England who have been resident in one of the qualifying countries for a period of ~~24~~ **18** consecutive months before the date of his request for registration, and he has not been out of these countries during that period for longer than 35 days consecutively nor 70 days in total.

## **D: RULES OF PLAY : Division 1,2&3 – Limited Over Cricket**

## Motion 6

*To clarify the reduced overs calculation – add section shown in italics below*

### DURATION

- 2.6 In the event of time being lost after the commencement of the match due to inclement weather or other cause during the innings of the team batting first, then the team batting first will receive 50 overs or as reduced prior to the start of the match. The team batting second will then have their maximum number of overs reduced by one over for each 3.5 minutes of play lost during the first innings. *Should there be more than one interruption to play the calculation for each interruption shall be considered separately*
